

## Roland Classroom Activity: RM700 Piano

Lesson: Visual Lesson

**Concepts:** Assessing playing accuracy and sightreading

**Grades:** 3-12, 20-50 minutes

## **Detailed Lesson Plan:**

Note: The following lesson plan includes a variety of skill levels. Visual Lesson is a practice feature that scores rhythmic and pitch accuracy. It may be used with songs stored in the piano or with any Standard MIDI file imported through the USB port on the piano.

- 1. Press MENU.
- 2. Press VISUAL LESSON (select Beginner, Repertoire or Challenge)
- 3. Follow the directions on the screen for Visual Lesson.

Select song

Select tempo

Press Play and perform song

Press Review to see rhythmic and pitch accuracy.

4. Repeat for desired accuracy or set time limit for practice.

Practice Left Hand Only Chord Recognition: "Railroad" (Repertoire)
Drill Right Hand Fingering: "Grandfather Clock" (Repertoire)
