

Roland Classroom Activity: RMP 5 Rhythm Coach

Lesson: Steady Beat Play Along

Concepts: Finding the pulse in a

piece of music.

Grades: 5-8, 20 minutes, individual

lesson or group class.

Preparation & Materials:.

This lesson uses an RCA to mini connecting cable in the MIX IN input on the RMP5.

One MP3 player per drum. Two drumsticks per student. Headphones.

National Standards Met:

Standard 2: Performing on instruments, alone and with others, a varied repertoire of music.

Students drum the pulse in a variety of music styles.

Standard 6: Listening to, analyzing, and describing music.

Students listen to audio files, find the pulse, then play.

Detailed Lesson Plan:

Note: This is an exploration lesson.

- 1. Direct students to find a FAST song on the MP3.
- 2. Tell students to first find the DOWNBEAT in the music and drum along.
- 3. Give students time to listen and play with the file.
- 4. Direct students to find a SLOWER song on the MP3.
- 5. Tell students to first find the DOWNBEAT in the music and drum along.
- 6. Give students time to listen and play with the file.
- 7. Discuss: Which song was easier to play? Why? Which was more fun? Why?
- 8. Talk about "driving" beats. Did the pulse of your songs move more "up and down" or "side to side"?
- 9. Open a conversation about the difference in patterns.
